### **Defect Details**

During the arrival maneuvering in Panamaribo, I noticed in the ECR switchboard panel of the N.2 SW pump as the amperage has fluctuations between 50 and 70 A. Outside the ECR, could see the sparks and imediately began to visible fire on the pump. We stopped the pump imediately, switch off the power, isolated the valves and checked visual area. Bridge was informed in the same time.

The pump support has cracked.

The pump shaft under operation moves downside and starts to grinding to pump's support. Polishing the pump support appear the sparks which are visibly growing. The upper part of the mechanical seal begins to be affected and take fire.
