A crew was filling dosing chemical to FW Expansion Tank manually by hand through the opened vertical manhole. Upon pouring, the chemical splashes to the inside surface of the tank and a small portion of chemical splash back to his arm. Immediately crew took his coverall out and go to common toilet and continuously put running water for about 15mins. Fortunately, no chemical burn or injury was observed.
