

Cyber incidents are anticipated to result in physical effects and potential safety and / or pollution incidents and preventive measures for this aspect are addressed in SMS chapter 14


Responsibilities

Master and Ship Security Officer shall ensure all shipboard activities are conducted in accordance with requirements of Ship Security Plan and any breach of security or difficulty in compliance shall be immediately reported to Company Security Officer for required guidance and assistance.

Procedure

The master and all crewmembers should give effect to those requirements stipulated in the Ship Security Plan and should be familiar with their duties. They should also undergo necessary on board training provided by the master or ship security officer designated by the Company.

Master should always bear in mind while taking decisions that Safety takes Precedence over Security.
